CITIZEN ENGAGEMENT: COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT



Bob, your citizen, would like a new community park. He shares his idea on social media, and it generates interest amongst his friends and neighbors.



Bob's local government is alerted of this trending topic by the AvePoint Podium social listening tools which monitor constituent sentiment.



The government adds an agenda item to discuss building a park at the next local town hall meeting, using AvePoint Podium to create an online forum that allows Bob and his neighbors to discuss the idea prior to and during the meeting.
