New Features and Improvements

- Added Incident Manager. From the new interface users can export reports, add an access policy, manage workflow runtime, manage retention policy and manage Report Center and the Feedback Center.
- Added a Secure token service (STS) into Compliance Guardian for Incident Management Center.
- Implemented the Check Manager interface.
- In Compliance Scanner: implemented the HTML GUI and logic change, added CCS logic for concurrent scanning, added security trimming for reports, added plan settings for SharePoint, File System, and website.
- In Classification Scanner: added the ability to create a custom action, added the Test Run function, updated the report database structure, and now support collecting the corresponding site properties before scanning a file, and then add the specified site properties to the file.
- In All Scan Records: support displaying the auditor information of a file, the permissions information, and the Issue Highlight Report.
- Improved the current Test Suite Manager interface. Added the guide mode for Fingerprinting checks and added the Combo type check for searching for SSN and credit card.
- Added a new risk algorithm:
A score of a check = (how damage of the information)*(how many violations)*(how accuracy we are sure on the found instance) = (severity level)*(the violation count)*(confidence level)
A score of a test suite = The total risk scores of all of the checks in the test suite (check 1+ check 2 + check 3...)
- Added the Subscription module in the Control Panel.
- In Job Monitor, added the Pause and Resume features to Control Panel.
- Support Compliance Guardian Powershell API.
- In Classification Real-time Scanner, support exporting the action settings to an XML file, and support importing the action settings to an XML file back to Compliance Guardian.
- Added the Performance Matrix tool.
- In Report Center, added the **Delete and Restore Original File/Decrypt Original File/Decrypt and Restore Original File** options when you select **Dispose** in the All Scan Records interface.
- Modified the Compliance Guardian Quarantine Manager logic. When you select the **Site Settings**, and then select **Compliance Guardian 4 Quarantine Manager 2010/ Compliance Guardian 4 Quarantine Manager 2013** in the Compliance Guardian 4 Tools and Services group in SharePoint, you will be redirected to the **Compliance Guardian Manager > Incident Manager** interface. You can perform the related actions to the file or document in Incident Manager.
- Made upgrades to the Control panel interface for better navigation. And made changed some the Control Panel module from Silverlight to HTML.
- Added the report details link in the alert e-mail notifications. Users can now view the scan details by selecting the link in the e-mail body.
- Support viewing a file's previous version's Issue Highlight report. Also added the **Violation Summary** and **Violations in Source** tabs.

- Added the SharePoint Online Connection mode in Connection Manager.
- Implemented the Custom Upload Page setting function.
- Added permissions in Access Mapping in Classification Real-time Scanner.
- Added the Lync Common File Types filter policy.
- Made improvements to Headmap and Trent Reports.

Known Issues

- Compliance Guardian cannot be opened from a Safari browser.
- The Scheduled Classification for Yammer job can only scan 240 notes.
- Users cannot perform the **Encrypt** and **Encrypt and Quarantine** (in-place quarantine) actions to files that have a checked out status in SharePoint.
- When applying a Real-Time Classification Scanner rule on a SharePoint Online site, the **Delete** and **Lock** actions do not work on the user profiles, notes in Note board and Newsfeed.
- Scheduled Classification Scanner will not scan files with a checked out status in SharePoint. The files must be checked in in order for them to be scanned.
- Incremental scanning is not supported for Oracle databases.
- Due to a limitation in the Yammer API which returns only a subset of information for each query, a scheduled classification scan may report complete before obtaining all messages.
- Rules applied to the Real-Time Classification Scanner on a SharePoint Online site cannot be triggered if the Compliance Guardian App is activated using a different Client ID.
- Compliance Guardian cannot be opened when using Windows 8.1 Pro and Internet Explorer browser version 11.0.9600.17416.
- If a full Compliance Scanner plan's status is Finished with Exception, the configured Report Retention Rule will not take effect.
- An incremental scan job cannot scan an item's attachment.

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
