## New Features and Improvements

- Support responsive web design for tablets and smart phones.
- Support scanning social content including Newsfeeds and user profiles for SharePoint Online.
- Now support Information Painter Reports and Incident Manager in Compliance Reports.
- Users can customize the look and feel of interface by editing settings in **Settings > Preference**.
- Made some modifications to the Compliance Guardian Transaction Capture tool.
- Now support Redaction type checks.
- Added version information for test suites and checks.
- Support Classification Scanner and Scheduled Classification Scanner modules.
- Support Action Policy and Action Report for the Classification Scanner module.
- In Group Management, now include details about permissions granted to group users.
- Support Quarantine, Encryption, and Redaction Managers in **Classification Reports > Incident Manager**.
- In Information Painter Reports, users can highlight violation information in the web page directly.
- In SharePoint Online, the alert profile is supported for Classification Scanner.
- Added Filter Policy for Classification Scanner in SharePoint Online.
- Added the **Save As** button in the Edit Action Policy interface.
- In Authentication Profile, now support the Form-based Authentication method.
- Can search profile name, test suite, and scan under **the Profile Manager** tab of the **Compliance Reports > Export All Requests to HTML interface**.
- In Classification Scanner, support moving files to other sites across an entire farm.
- In Action Policy, users can enter the relative library path of the library or folder to move files in the same site.

## Known Issues

- Compliance Guardian Online does not support scanning Access App in SharePoint Online.
- When using Opera or Google Chroma as a browser, users cannot open the HTML report exported using the Export All Requests to HTML function in Compliance Reports.

Workaround – Go to **Properties** in Google Chrome or Opera. The Properties window appears. Under the **Shortcut** tab, add a space after the Target URL, and then enter "**--allow-file-access-from-files**" after the space. Select **Apply** and close the window. From the browser, select **Run as administrator**. Drag the **index.html** to the browser. Or you can double click the **index.html** file and select **Open With** from the drop-down list. You should now be able to open the report.

- When using Safari browser or a Mac Operating System, users cannot open the HTML report exported using the Export All Requests to HTML function in Compliance Reports.

Workaround - Select **Show Develop** in **Preferences** of the Safari browser. Select **Disable Local File Restrictions** from the drop-down list.

- If the scanned web page title contains &, \_ , Japanese or Chinese characters, the corresponding page title report in the exported datasheet cannot be displayed correctly.

Workaround – Open Microsoft Excel and select the **Data** tab. Select **From Text** on the ribbon, and then select the exported datasheet (the CSV file). The **Text Import Wizard** window appears. Select **65001: Unicode (UTF-8)** as the File origin and then select **Finish**.

- Trouble uploading images when using Internet Explorer 9. In the **Compliance Reports > Export All Requests to HTML > Export Report Settings interface**, upload the header or footer image. The image will not display in the interface but can be seen in the exported file. Upload the image again. The image will display correctly when uploaded the second time.
- Limitation when using a spider profile to scan websites. Select **Enable rendered crawl** when creating a spider profile. Select an authentication profile with certificate. When you scan a website using the spider profile, the rendered crawl functionality will not work. This happens because the third-party browser toolkit does not support the Certificate.
