New Features and Improvements

- The addition of a DocAve Governance Automation web part embeds the business user interface into SharePoint providing users with a more seamless experience.
- A shortcut has been added to the Governance Automation local folder for the Manage Existing Site Collection tool.
- Custom user information databases are now supported for customers not using the User Profile Service. This can be achieved by adding a customized DLL file to the Governance Automation bin folder and modifying the global configuration file. Known Issues

- The DocAve Governance Automation web part is displayed in the same language as the browser rather than the language used by the site the web part is in. Make sure that the browser language is the same as that of the site to avoid display issues.
- Before accessing the DocAve Governance Automation web part using Internet Explorer 8, the DocAve Governance Automation URL must be added as a trusted site. Open **Internet Options** in Internet Explorer > go to the **Security** tab > click **Trusted sites** > click **Sites** > enter the DocAve Governance Automation URL without the port number to the **Add this website to the zone:** textbox and click **Add** > click **Close** and then **OK** to save the settings.
