## New Features

- **SharePoint 2010 Support and Enhancements**

All modules have been updated to support SharePoint 2010 and SharePoint Foundation 2010. Along with adding support for all previous DocAve functionality, each module has been updated to support the new features found in SharePoint 2010 as well; examples include support for operations on the site importance web part, keyword searching and management, and search, offline availability, and ratings for the Central Administrator. For a full list of supported functions in SharePoint 2010 please see the DocAve User Guide.

- **Enhanced Sprawl Control Functionality**

Dead Account Cleaner and Permissions Transferring can now take place at the Farm and Web Application level from Central Administrator. Orphaned sites can now be automatically deleted based on applicable business rules. The DocAve Environment Discovery Tool has been augmented to give administrators a more complete picture of their environment, allowing administrators to more effectively deploy DocAve and harness the functions of its modules.

- **Drastically Improved Media Service Performance Benchmarks**

AvePoint and independent testing both show drastic improvement for Media Service disk I/O speed; improving the speed of Backup and Restore jobs and all Storage Optimization functions. The Report Center also has a new report to show the average throughput between Agent services; showing connection speed and exposing bottlenecks in your environment.

## Bug Fixes

- **Additional IIS Restart Notifications**

As logging level changes now require an IIS reset, DocAve has been updated to include notifications to inform users of IIS restarts when changing the level of detail included in DocAve-related IIS logs. Developers have also corrected an issue that was preventing IIS logs from being retrieved after *Logging Source IPs* was enabled.

- **FBA Authentication now integrated into SharePoint Security Center**

Users created with Form-Based Authentication are now able to be searched for and operated on in Administrator's Security Center.

- **Using Deployment Manager with Wiki Pages in SharePoint 2010**

Wiki pages, which typically utilize a different page structure than traditional SharePoint pages, can now be promoted and demoted to site collections or sub-sites using Design Manager and have new templates applied to them with Design Manager jobs.

- **Backing up Discussion Board Item Attachments**

Previously, when performing an *item level backup*, individual attachments of discussion board items were not able to be included in a Backup plan. DocAve 5.5.2 can now granularly back up and restore a discussion board item's attachments.

- **Improved PowerShell File System Migration Process**

DocAve 5.5.2 includes a new, more powerful PowerShell based File System Migrator which has been updated from previous versions to include additional functionality and more robust capabilities.

- **Viewing Media Library Videos if Internet Explorer zoom is not set to 100%**

In earlier versions of the Extender media libraries, videos were not able to be played if the zoom level of the browser was set to anything but 100%. With DocAve 5.5.2, developers have addressed this issue and videos can now be played regardless of the browser's zoom level.

- **Usage analytics in a Network Load-Balanced Environment**

New site collections added to a Network Load-Balanced (NLB) environment will now be automatically be discovered by the Report Center's Usage Analytics report.

## **Known Issues**

- **Content Selection Issues when using 'Include New' for Content Manager on Microsoft Office SharePoint Server 2007**

When selecting content to include in a Content Manager job, please ensure to expand all sub-nodes containing content beneath the level you wish to select. Sub-content beneath the parent level selected may not be included if the SharePoint tree is not completely expanded.

- **Custom Permissions management and Publishing Portal Issue with Deployment Manger Operating on Microsoft Office SharePoint Server 2007**

If you are using Deployment manager to push Portal Site Collections, contextual My Links are not currently able to be deployed, though the rest of the content will move successfully. Custom permissions assigned at a Sub-site

level are also not able to be deployed with Design Manager jobs. Developers are currently working on a fix for both issues.

- **Minor issues replicating Site Collection Policies and Image Thumbnails in Microsoft Office SharePoint Server 2007**

Due to the architecture of SharePoint Site Collection policies, when performing a new full replication job after modifying a Site Collection policy, the DocAve job will complete without errors, however, an error will appear when accessing the Site Collection policy on the destination site collection. Please maintain Site Collection policies through the native SharePoint manager. When replicating images that have been uploaded to an extended folder, thumbnails of those images are not able to be replicated, note that the files have been successfully replicated.

- **Security Center unable to Import/Export Limited Access Permissions for Windows SharePoint Services 3.0**

If using the Export/Import function of Administrator, any users Exported with Limited Access must be changed within the Security Center interface, the Import/Export function cannot alter the permissions of these users.

- **eDiscovery Search Limitations for Windows SharePoint Services 3.0.**

Currently, eDiscovery searches performed on Windows SharePoint Services will only return results from the Web Application and Site Collection level.

- **High Availability Mirroring Failback not available for SharePoint 2010**

High Availability SQL Mirroring is not available for SharePoint 2010. Please utilize log-shipping for your High Availability needs.

- **Limited Advanced Platform Restoration capabilities for Microsoft Office SharePoint Server 2007**

Previously, administrators have modified properties in zeus-media in order to increase the block data size. This is not possible for version 5.5.2. Also, Collaboration portal root site collections must be restored at the same level. If these sites are restored at the site or subsite level, the page will not be able to be opened.

- **Email Notifications not sent for Blob Storage Trends in Microsoft Office SharePoint Server 2007.**

Email notifications cannot currently be utilized to notify administrators about their Blob Storage trends.

- **Storage Optimization implications for Upgraded Environments**

Due to a potential Microsoft SharePoint API defect occurring in environments upgraded from Microsoft Office 2007 to SharePoint 2010, Connector is not available for those environments which have been upgraded in place.
