New Features and Enhancements

- **DocAve Data Protection Enhancements**

Restore from SQL now able to restore from backups split across multiple files

DocAve Restore from SQL is now able to build backup plans from multiple SQL backups and restore this content in one job. If the same file is restored from two or more SQL backups, they will either be restored as versions of the same file or the most recently modified version will be restored.

SiteBin now licensed as Granular Backup Add-on

Due to overlap in functionality after enhancements to both modules, DocAve SiteBin will no longer be sold individually, and may only be added on to the Granular Backup module or acquired through purchased of the Data Protection Suite.

Beta Workflow State Backup and Recovery Support for Qualified Customers

For qualified customers, Backup and Recovery for SharePoint 2007 can be configured with the assistance of AvePoint Technical Support to granularly support workflow states, including workflow history and related tasks. Please contact AvePoint Technical Support if you wish to begin the qualification process for your environment.

- **DocAve Administration Enhancements**

New Web Part Report and Broken Link Checker Tool

Administrators now have the ability to run a report which will browse the SharePoint environment and report back on the number, type, and location of web parts within the selected scope. The Broken Link Checking tool will list all broken links in sites within the selected scope, and when applicable, will specify the reason for the specified link. The Web Part Report can be run from the Central Admin menu, and the Broken Link Checking tool is an external tool.

Perform Test Runs on Content Manager and Design Manager Jobs

Similar to the DocAve Migrator test runs, you may now preview the results of a Design Manager or Content Manager Job before execution by selecting Test Run. This will simulate the operation while leaving your environment untouched.

Enhanced Version-based Operations in Content Manager

When performing content moving operations in SharePoint environments where versioning has been enabled, Administrators may now elect to move the latest Major version only, or move the latest major version of an item along with all minor versions.

Mass Deploy Content Types or Custom Document Libraries across Web Applications

With DocAve Designer Manager Administrators can now deploy a custom content type into any web application present in their environment. Custom document libraries can also be deployed at the Web Application level.

- **DocAve Storage Optimization Enhancements**

Enhancement to DocAve Connector Including the Connector SDK

Administrators can now automatically provision, configure, and deploy Connector Media or File Share Libraries via the Connector SDK. For more detailed information, please refer to the DocAve User Guide. Connector Media Libraries are also now supported in SharePoint Foundation 2010.

Expanded content type coverage of DocAve Archiver operations and filter options

Administrators are now able to granularly archive custom site properties. Going along with DocAve enhanced workflow support, Administrators are additionally able to archive SharePoint content or items based on the objects workflow status, and are no longer required to treat this as a custom column.

EBS to RBS Migration Capabilities Explained

For those administrators who have upgraded from SharePoint 2007 to SharePoint 2010 and wish to utilize RBS to externalize content instead of their current EBS setup, we have outlined the steps to migrate from the EBS API to the RBS API in the DocAve User Guide. Enhancements have also been made to ensure that access to externalized content is maintained throughout upgrades to the DocAve platform.

- **DocAve Migration Enhancements**

Augmented SharePoint 2007 to SharePoint 2010 Migration Content and Component Coverage

Numerous improvements and additions have been made to the DocAve SharePoint 2007 to SharePoint 2010 Migrator Including:

- Version Filtering (Major and Minor Versions, Major Versions Only, Major and associated minor versions only)

- Time Range Filtering
- Migration of DocAve archived data from SharePoint 2007 farms to SharePoint 2010 farms
- Site template replacement settings, list template replacement settings, and field mapping replacement settings
- Custom or standard master page migrations

New Pre-scan tool for EMC Documentum Migration

Similar to our other DocAve Migrators, the EMC Documentum to SharePoint 2010 Migrator now has a pre-scan tool, allowing Administrators to preview the results of migrations without any changes being made to their environment. Please refer to the DocAve User guide for detailed instructions.
