Improvements and New Features

- **Full Support for SharePoint 2010**

Website Migrator fully supports SharePoint 2010, as well as existing support for SharePoint online. Test this product with your new beta code from Microsoft, due for public distribution in Q4 2009.

- **Generic Rules for Custom Columns**

The support for customizing generic rules in Website Migrator has been added, supporting taking any specified structured tag in the source HTML site and migrating its value to a new user-specified property on the new SharePoint page.

- **CLI Support Added for Migration**

Website Migrator now supports performing batch execution of migration plans via the CLI interface, triggering multiple plans at once while still allowing you the flexibility over migration types. See the documentation for more updates.

- **Organization of Migrated Contents - Images**

In order to improve organization, you can now split where documents and images are filtered in SharePoint (different root directories / libraries).

Bug Fixes

- **Enhanced Functionality for "Correct Page Structure"**

Based on the feedback of several customer examples, this option has been adjusted to provide much more accurate representation of page structures in SharePoint.

- **Support for SharePoint 2010 Web Service Migration**

Due to limitations in the current SharePoint 2010 build, Website Migrator did not support migration to SharePoint 2010 over web services.

- **Support for SharePoint 2010 Publishing Sites**

Website Migrator was unable to update the website URLs when using a SharePoint publishing website as the destination.

Known Issue

- **Support for SharePoint 2010 Web Service Migration**

Due to limitations in the current SharePoint 2010 build, Website Migrator did not support migration to SharePoint 2010 over web services.
