New Features and Improvements

- The master page and publishing override features provided by AvePoint Accessibility Accelerator now support SharePoint 2013 farms.

Known Issues

- If you activate the **Accessibility Adapter for SharePoint 2013 Http Module** feature on a SharePoint 2013 farm, and change the master page of a site collection to the one provided by AvePoint Accessibility Accelerator, then an error page will appear if a file is quarantined when it is uploaded to a site in a site collection. The text on this error page cannot be changed because the error page uses a separate HTML file and does not inherit the master page provided by AvePoint Accessibility Accelerator.
- In a SharePoint 2013 farm, if you activate the **Publishing** feature of the site collection in SharePoint 2010 experience version, and then change its master page, the operation will fail. The site collection using SharePoint 2010 experience version in the SharePoint 2013 farm cannot be changed to apply another master page due to a SharePoint limitation.
