New Features and Improvements

- There is now an AD Integration feature to enable granting permissions of custom groups to the users that are in domain groups.
- When creating or editing sessions, uploaded thumbnail images can now be deleted.
- You can now update to a new version without uninstalling the app.
- Custom app part tiles can now be configured.

New Features and Improvements

- Users can now generate reports which can be used to analyze attendance rates, audience characteristics, and questionnaire responses, etc.
- AvePoint Podium supports creating and managing live and on-demand sessions.
- Security roles can now be created to define user permission levels for AvePoint Podium.
- Forms can be generated and managed such as questionnaires, registration forms, or surveys, which can be used during sessions.
- AvePoint Podium Broadcasting Policies and Media Services Connection Profiles for session broadcasting can now be configured.
- The AvePoint Podium app parts that are displayed on the session portal can now be customized.
- The global look and feel of AvePoint Podium app parts can now be configured.
- Sessions can now be sorted by their start time in the Session Management interface.
- When installing the AvePoint Podium package to a SharePoint 2016 environment, users will receive a prompt that AvePoint Podium does not support SharePoint 2016.
- Users can display all of the sessions that are viewed or liked during the time period selected from the drop-down list in the upper-right corner of the Report interface.
- There is now a tooltip that displays detailed information when an error occurs while performing an action.
- Channels will now be occupied by live sessions beginning one hour before the start time of the session until the end of the session.
- IIS is not reset when installing the AvePoint Podium package.
- AvePoint Podium app parts now support anonymous access.
- An .ics file is generated when a user clicks the **Add to my calendar** button in a Session List app part in the Slide Show layout. The .ics file includes the basic information of the session and a link to the corresponding session page.

Known Issues

- When managing security for AvePoint Podium, only SharePoint groups and AD users can be added to a Podium group. AD groups cannot be added to a Podium group.
