# New Features and Improvements

- Ability to upload test definition files (TDFs) in bulk with the TDF Collection Manager.
- New TDF Validator tool allows users to validate the structure and logic of TDF and TDF Collection files.
- **Save As** option added to the **Edit Filter Policy** interface.
- **Stop** action added to **Job Monitor** to provide the ability to stop selected in-progress jobs.
- A file's **Approval** status is now stored in SharePoint after adding tags to it in a Classification Scanner job.
- Support for scanning "Very Hidden" Excel worksheets.
- Added the **Alert** function to notify specified recipients when the application of metadata tags fails.
- Added the option to include previous versions of a file in a Compliance Scan.
- Added the capability to create, delete, and edit TDFs and TDF collections in the TDF Collection Manager.
- The Fax number TDF has been enhanced to improve search accuracy.
- The URL in the **File Location** column is now accessible in the Compliance Guardian Report.
- Added the **CompareType** attribute in the **Dictionary** type TDF.
- Added support to upload TDFs that are the same as existing TDFs in Compliance Guardian.
- Out of the box TDF collections have been added and updated to map to specific compliance regulations.
- Improved accuracy of the Job Progress bar.
- Added a configuration file allowing users to set a timeout for a Compliance Guardian job.
- Added the ability to customize the default filter policy.
- Improved support to scan German and French special characters.
- Improved support to add tags to an ASPX file. In the previous logic, only the ASPX file that contains the <head/> node can have a metadata tag applied.
- In the Violation Trend Report, the top five TDFs will be selected automatically, and the corresponding data will be displayed in the report.
- The Violation Trend Report now filters the TDFs available to display by only those that had violations for the currently selected scan scope.
- Real Time Classification plans applied to a parent object will now automatically be inherited to newly created child objects.
- When configuring an action policy, the Action Policy Filter input fields will be populated with values from Compliance Scanner TDF Collections (metadata compliance collections (.mcc)) that are configured in the TDF Collection Manager.

## Known Issues

- When scanning file versions, incremental scan jobs will not just scan incremental versions, they will scan all file versions as if they were full scan jobs.
- Incremental scan jobs cannot scan attachments to an item due to a limitation in the SharePoint API.
- In Japanese environments, dates in a Microsoft Excel file cannot be scanned. As a workaround, users can change the Date Format of the machine where the Compliance Guardian Agent resides to YYYY-MM-DD.
- In Japanese environments, if a user runs a Compliance Guardian Scanner job, a TDF collection with a Japanese name is included in the job. After the job completes, the exported scan result report does not contain any data.

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
