New Features

- **SharePoint 2010 Support and Enhancements**

All DocAve Content Shield functions have been updated to support SharePoint 2010 and SharePoint Foundation 2010. Along with adding support for all previous functionality, DocAve Content Shield has been updated to support the new features found in SharePoint 2010 as well. For a full list of supported functions in SharePoint 2010 please see the DocAve Content Shield User Guide.

- **Support for DocAve Archiver Stubs**

DocAve can now be utilized to scan the “stubs”, or the small amount of metadata left in SQL by the DocAve Archiver to ensure that those stubs do not contain any offending content. This ensures that the SharePoint metadata entered in when the content is uploaded is compliant.

- **Enhanced file filtering based on file type, not extension**

DocAve Content Shield now scans deeper than just reviewing the file extension to determine the actual nature of the file. This will prevent unauthorized uploading of file types in which the file extension has been altered, ensuring full compliance within your environment.

Bug Fixes

- **Multiple filter plans now configurable for each SharePoint node**

As per customer requests, multiple scanning engines can now be configured for each SharePoint node. Please note that configuring multiple plans on the same node may have negative consequences to your SharePoint environment if there are insufficient resources available. Please review the DocAve Content Shield user guide for resource requirements.

Known Issues

- **Compatibility with Antivirus 2.0 in SharePoint 2007 environments**

Due to a bug with real-time scanning in DocAve Antivirus 2.0, scheduled filtering will not take effect in environments where both the DocAve Content Shield 2.0 and DocAve Antivirus 2.0 are installed. This bug will be addressed with the release of DocAve Antivirus 3.0.
