## New Features and Enhancements

- DocAve Content Shield for SharePoint now includes pre-configured HIPAA/PII dictionaries.
- Customizable Risk Values have been added to allow flexibility in managing non-compliant files detected by DocAve Content Shield for SharePoint.
- Risk Reports are now available after Scheduled Filter scan jobs are run, providing detailed information on each violation detected by the Scheduled Filter.
- Real-Time Filters of DocAve Content Shield for SharePoint can now be configured to generate summary e-mail reports of violations on a customized schedule.
- Added illegal character recognition for customized metadata columns to improve illegal content detection.
- Improved illegal character recognition for customized metadata columns to Scheduled Filter scans.

## Known Issues

- Quarantined items are still being scanned by Scheduled Filters of DocAve Content Shield for SharePoint 2007.

## Bug Fixes

- Libraries with workflow enabled can now be correctly scanned. Real-Time Filter scans and Scheduled Filter scans now properly support libraries that have workflow enabled.
- Scheduled Filters now block only the non-compliant version(s) of a file.
- Deleting a Real-Time Filter now correctly removes the associated Event Handlers.
