Known Issues

For Administrators:

- The timer service and Governance Automation Workflow service must be manually restarted whenever the host server for the Governance Automation Manager is restarted. Please make sure this step is a part of your system maintenance.
- Upon Service Request completion, the users configured for the **CC:** field for the notification e-mail will appear in the **To:** field instead.
- Report Export Location using the UNC Path format `\\ServerName\SharedFolder` causes permissions issues when exporting reports to a datasheet. In order to avoid this issue, use the UNC Path format `\\ServerName\C$\FolderName` instead.
- When creating Metadata, if **Multiple lines of text** is selected, leaving the **Default Value** blank will result in an error message when editing that Metadata in a Create Site Collection Service or Create Site Service interface.
- **Person or Group** Metadata containing an apostrophe in the **Default Value** textbox causes an error message when submitting a request for a Service that uses this Metadata. As a result, the Service Request cannot be submitted for approval.
- When creating a Service, if the option **Assign by IT Admin** is selected in the Secondary Site Collection Administrator field, and the username entered in the **Default value** textbox contains an apostrophe, the Secondary Site Collection Administrator column will not contain any information in reports.
