New Features and Improvements

- The user interface has been revamped for a more intuitive experience.
- Added integration with DocAve Deployment Manager. This allows admins to enforce consistency in content types and site themes for site collections created or managed by Governance Automation.
- Added integration with DocAve Content Manager to provide users the ability to request moving or copying content with full Governance Automation auditing.
- Added API support for site collection and site provisioning service requests to support integration with existing or custom service request applications. Provisioning requests using the supported API will still be audited and managed via Governance Automation.
- Lease periods for site collections can now be set by the requester to provide more flexibility for the end user.
- Added Site lifecycle management services to automate lease extension and site deletion. Sites inherit lifecycle management settings from the site collection they are created under.
- Added option for setting depth limit for site collection policies to help maintain structural organization.
- Added the ability to reassign tasks when escalating a request to avoid prolonged delays in business processes.
- Added support for customizing workflows by adding actions to Approval Processes before or after they are initiated.
- Added Change Site Metadata service to allow reclassification of sites.
- Added Change Site Contact service to allow transfer of site ownership due to personnel shifts.
- Added support for unattended installation.

Known Issues

- When accessing the Governance Automation Web part using Internet Explorer, users may encounter errors. To resolve this, navigate to **Internet Options** > **Security** tab > **Trusted Sites**, and add the URL for Governance Automation to the trusted sites without the port number.
