Known Issues

- In Internet Explorer 8, when using the manual sync, Upload, New Folder, and View Report features, the job window may not close after the job completes. As a workaround, manually close the window by clicking **X** on the upper-right corner of the window.
- If a File Share Navigator Online list contains more than 5,000 files, the files may not be viewable in the list, and ribbon buttons may be unresponsive. This issue occurs because SharePoint Online uses the Large List Resource Throttling feature, which is set at 5,000 items.
- In the Upload Multiple Documents interface, if you cancel the upload of a document that is less than 16 MB, files may remain in both SharePoint Online and storage. As a workaround, manually remove the remaining file from the storage location and perform a synchronization job.
- The New Item feature in File Share Navigator Online lists may not function even though the button is available on the ribbon. In File Share Navigator Online 1.0, you can create an item in the list, but the item cannot be synchronized to the storage location, and the item will be deleted after a synchronization job. The New Item feature will be hidden from the ribbon in a later version of File Share Navigator Online.
- If deleting File Share Navigator Online lists from the List Settings interface of SharePoint Online, the list will not be permanently deleted. The list can only be permanently deleted in the View Lists interface of the File Share Navigator Online App.
- File paths are limited to 260 characters, but File Share Navigator Online will allow you to initially upload a folder that exceeds the limit if the folder name length is less than 128 characters, and the path where the file resides is less than 260 characters. If you try to upload the same file again or perform a synchronization job, the update fails due to a SharePoint API limitation.
