Data Protection

• Data Pruning Support for Platform-level Backup Jobs

Users can now define data pruning rules for Platform Level backup plans, allowing you to automatically prune content from your storage devices.

• Download Security Search Results in SPAdmin

After obtaining a table of search results, users can now download these results from the GUI. Downloading reports in XML is not currently supported.

"Site Level Deployment" is renamed to "Design Manager"

In order to emphasize the focus of the Deployment Manager's module ability in managing SharePoint Design elements, this module has been renamed. All plans, configurations, and functions have been maintained.

Lotus Notes Support for x64 Machines

DocAve now supports migration of content from 64-bit machines into SharePoint.

General

Support for TSM Has Been Added

Users can now map directly to IBM's TSM storage system from the Device Manager in DocAve, allowing users to store data generated from the Criticality Matrix and the Granular Backup builder. Platform-level backup data is not yet supported.

• E-mail Notification Support for Multiple Addresses

DocAve now allows you to define e-mail notification rules for multiple addresses.

Extension Archiver for Items Over 750 MB in Size

Extension Archiver support has been added for files over 750 MB in size.

Known Issues

General

SSL Support for Remote Agent Installation

When using the Remote Installation feature from the DocAve GUI for the Agents, SSL cannot be configured. You must log-in to the Agent machine to configure this option.

• Stop Button Support

The "Stop" button in the GUI is not able to stop all functions in DocAve.

Replicator Support for x64 Machines in Two-Way Replication

The time-based conflict resolution rule has errors when performing two way replication between 64-bit machines.

Data Protection

VSS Support for Index Servers

Platform-level backup cannot restore the Index Server backed up with VSS if the index server has been installed separately.
