Bug Fixes

- **Enhanced stability for all End-user Web Parts when Restoring or Migrating with DocAve**

Archiver Browser web part no longer requires re-installation after Restore Jobs

Administrators are no longer required to re-install the Archiver Browser web part, which appears when a site or site collection has been archived, after restoring a site or site collection using the Data Protection module. The Archiver browser will now appear as normal without any administrator assistance required.

End-user Restore web part no longer requires re-configuration after Upgrading

Administrators are no longer required to re-configure the End User Restore web part after upgrading from an earlier version of DocAve. Previously, administrators were required to un-install and then reconfigure this web part before upgrading DocAve.

Report Center web part now includes all modules for SharePoint 2010 reporting data

The Report Center web part now includes additional data sets from SharePoint 2010 reports such as Site Usage, Last Accessed Time, Check Out Document, Search Usage, and the Blob Calculator.

- **Improved Stability for Granular Restoration for Extended, Multiple Versioned List and Libraries**

Previously, if an Extender policy was set for a site collection containing multiple versions for each item in the list or library, and then that list or library was backed up with either *Analyze SQL Backup* or *Item Versions* selected, a single version of an item from that backup was not able to be restored. This error has been addressed in DocAve 5.5.3, and now versions can be restored for content with many versions.

- **Improved Extender Cloud Storage Capabilities and stability**

In certain scenarios facing administrators, Extender was previously only able to be configured for one site collection at a time. Now, administrators are able to extend multiple site collections to cloud storage in one batch job despite selecting *Extend existing content*, *Media Service Encryption*, and/or *Agent Compression*. Administrators

had also previously reported issues accessing versions of documents when recalling archived and extended content from lower tiered storage; this has been resolved in DocAve 5.5.3.

- **Unable to Coalesce Restore Jobs in certain Backup Configurations**

Administrators had reported that after running a full backup, followed by an incremental backup, and then restoring from that incremental job, if a new item was added to the backed up location and an additional incremental job was run, the new content was unable to be restored. DocAve 5.5.3 has addressed this issue and will now restore from any incremental job.

- **Resolved SharePoint Auditor plan building errors when working across different content Databases**

Previously, if an auditor plan was configured at the web application level, but the site collections contained in the web application were split across multiple content databases, only the operation record of one of the site collections was able to be retrieved. Similarly, if a previously deleted site collection resided on one content database, an administrator would not be able to successfully collect audit data on the restored site collections if it was restored to a different content database. Both of these issues have been resolved in DocAve 5.5.3.

Known Issues

- **Unable to move conflicting content or content edited with SharePoint Designer 2010 in Content Manager**

If attempting to use Content Manager to move a folder to another folder with a different name with the *Not Overwrite* option selected, and if the folder IDs conflict, the content in the destination folder will still be overwritten. Please ensure that when moving content with Content Manager and attempting to not overwrite existing content, both the source and destination folders must have the same name. Additionally, if attempting to move a SharePoint 2010 site collection with Content Manager, custom list views created or modified with SharePoint Designer 2010 are not able to be moved along with content at this time.

- ***Don't Show Again* option affecting all pop-ups when building Replicator plan**

When creating a replicator plan and selecting a hyperlink which will take the administrator off of the current page, a pop-up appears warning that all unsaved configurations will be lost which can be disabled by selecting *Don't Show Again* and clicking OK. If *Don't Show Again* is selected it will block all pop-ups which appear when building a Replicator plan, and as such it is highly recommended not to select this option.

- **Time display configuration exception when scheduling to Extend library with existing content**

If utilizing Extender, please ensure that the time type is not set as "HH:mm:ss" and the date type is not set as "d.M.yy." If these values are selected from the System Settings in the Control Panel, error messages will appear when attempting to schedule to extend a library while extending the existing content of that library.

- **Unable to modify Index Petition for Shared Search Application**

If planning to perform a platform level backup, please do not modify the Index Petition for the Shared Search Application as the backup job will complete, but with exceptions due to this modification.
