New Features and Enhancements

Support for SharePoint 2010 Service Pack 1

- Service Pack 1 for Microsoft SharePoint was recently released. DocAve version 5.7 has been fully validated on this version, including testing for such features as compatibility with SharePoint site recycle bin and Shallow Copy for movement of RBS content between databases. Customers using previous versions of DocAve are encouraged to upgrade to ensure the best compatibility with Service Pack 1.

Storage Optimization Enhancements

- Media Service management for geographically distributed farms has become easier, allowing users to more intelligently assign roles and select media services for serving content and processing archiving jobs. For more detailed descriptions, please reference the Storage Optimization white paper concerning SharePoint scalability and disaster recovery strategies.

Disaster Recovery Support – 3rd Party Vendor Support

- Customizations on SharePoint can be a challenge for disaster recovery. DocAve 5.7 introduces support for Nintex Workflows 2010, KnowledgeLake 2010, NewsGator Social Sites 2010, and other generic customizations deployed to SharePoint including: application databases, solutions, features, service applications, file-system binaries, SharePoint GAC and Hive, and other SharePoint dependencies including content databases and elements like User Profile services.

DocAve InstaMount™ Technology for Fast Recovery

- Item level recovery from databases commonly requires SharePoint databases to be staged, a costly process and part of the challenge in meeting aggressive SLAs. AvePoint's Virtual SQL Database solution allows users to restore from any SQL database backup, including those triggered by DocAve Platform Level Backup and Recovery solution, without staging the database first, combining the industry's most powerful item-level recovery solution with the technology to dramatically accelerate restores.

Security Management Web Part for SharePoint

- DocAve Administrator security management's security-trimmed interface is now available directly in SharePoint as a solution, allowing users manage permissions, perform security searches, clone permissions, and other common security tasks.



DocAve Administration Enhancements

- DocAve Administration Suite has undergone several enhancements including performance enhancements for large environment reporting, alert management for dead-account cleaner, and mass deployment of SharePoint content types.

Migration to SharePoint 2010 enhancements

- Migration from sources including SharePoint 2007, File Systems, and eRoom have been enhanced allowing for management of topology during migration, visual upgrades, workflow support, metadata mapping, and enhanced role scanning and mapping.

Known Issues

- Custom Metadata for Master-Pages is not supported when performing DocAve Content Manager moves in order to prevent common page loading issues.
- Broken Link Reporting in DocAve Central Admin does not currently report on URLs within link lists when part of sites leveraging host-headers.
- NewsGator Support includes database level backup and recovery of content within SharePoint with any corresponding SharePoint elements and configurations specific to NewsGator. It must be noted that during a disaster, NewsGator must first be installed with its license key prior to running a recovery job in DocAve.
- Custom Metadata for Master-Pages is not supported when performing DocAve Content Manager moves in order to prevent common page loading issues.
- Internet Explorer 9 users must clear cache before running DocAve 5.7 if upgrading from a previous version of DocAve. Please note that when clearing cache, the option to *Preserve Favorites website data* (found within Delete Browsing History) must be unchecked.
