New Features

Platform

- All DocAve 5 products now include French language support.

Known Issues

High Availability

- If a job fails as a result of one or more High Availability Agents having no license, the job report and log do not list the reason for the failed job.
- After upgrading MOSS 2007 to SharePoint 2010, High Availability plans created in a MOSS 2007 environment cannot be loaded into the High Availability\Rule Builder interface.

Granular Backup and Restore

- If Advanced Search **Type** is **File Attribute** and the **Criteria** includes a \, executing the search causes a grayed-out interface and no search results.

Workaround: In the **Criteria** field, this issue can be solved if you replace \ with \\.

SiteBin

- Content will not successfully back up and can't be leveraged for restore when the SiteBin license has expired.

Workaround: To make this a cleaner deletion process and to improve performance, retract the SiteBin solution from SharePoint.

Connector

- Users who have **Add Items** permission (or lower) cannot upload a large file using the **Upload Large Document** method in SharePoint.

Workaround: Granting the users **Add and Customize Pages** permission (or higher) enables the large file to be uploaded.

- An error may occur while playing a video whose name contains special characters (Chinese, French, etc.) in a SharePoint 2007/2010 Connector Media Library.

Restore from SQL

- In SharePoint 2007 and SharePoint 2010 environments, files backed up by Data Protection Manager 2007 cannot be analyzed by DocAve and the Analyze SQL Backup job will fail.

Content Manager

- The source library's Search setting is not copied to the destination library after a Content Manager job.
